Know which colours are warm and cold.</p>	<p>Make marks in print with a variety of objects.</p> <p>Carry out different printing techniques eg foam tile printing.</p> <p>Build a repeating pattern and recognise pattern in the environment.</p>	<p>Use a variety of techniques eg. weaving and plaiting.</p> <p>Know how to cut and trim material.</p> <p>Use a wide variety of media, including fabric, plastic, tissue, magazines, crepe paper etc.</p>	<p>Manipulate clay in a variety of ways eg. rolling, kneading and shaping.</p> <p>Explore sculpture and texture with a range of malleable media such as clay.</p> <p>Explore shape and form.</p>	<p>Explore ideas using digital sources eg.
