developing oracy in Art	
and Design	
Defending Conclusions Reached	By defending conclusions, using given sentence stems, students think more critically about given artistic works and artistic styles; they will consider how art reflects and shapes our history, and contributes to the culture, creativity and wealth of our nation.
Group Discussion	The purpose of group discussion is to inspire curiosity in the embodiment of human creativity, equipping them with the knowledge and skills to experiment, invent and create their own works of art.
Self-Reflection	Through the oracy progression, students are invited to change their mind based on what they have heard. In doing so, pupils develop their evaluative and analytical skills through the language of art.
Stimulus for Narrative and Ideas	We use art as a stimulus for creative expression across the curriculum. Students use accompanying oracy skills to portray the consequential ideas in given subjects.
Describing Artistic Work	Within art, we insist that artistic vocabulary is used when describing the work of great artists, their own work and that of their peers. Examples of this can be seen during in class artexhibitions.
